

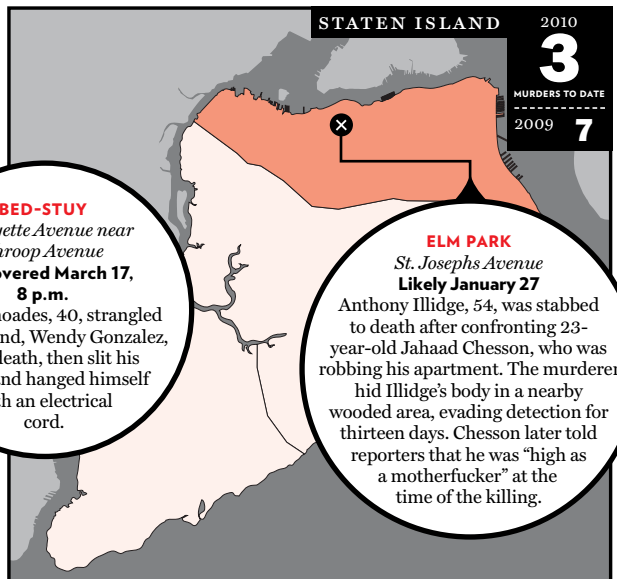
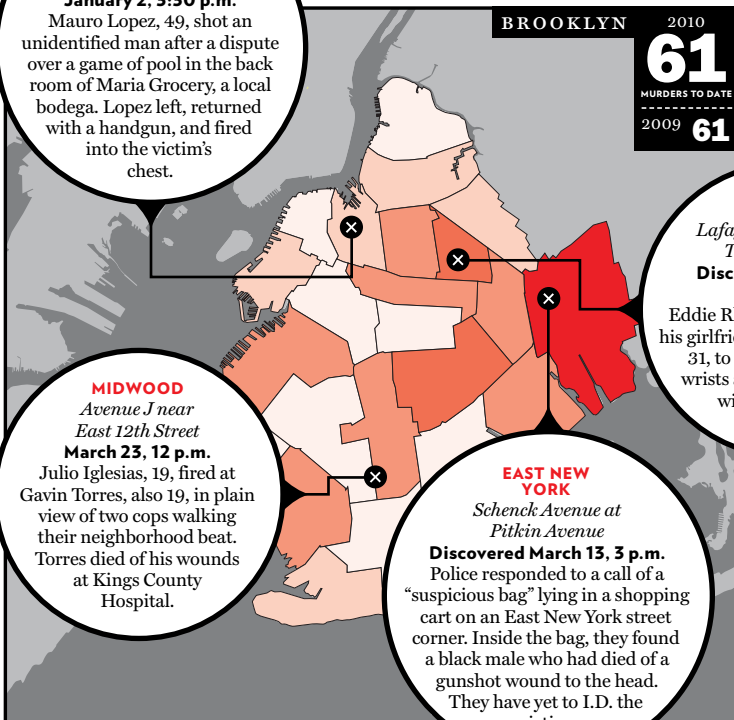
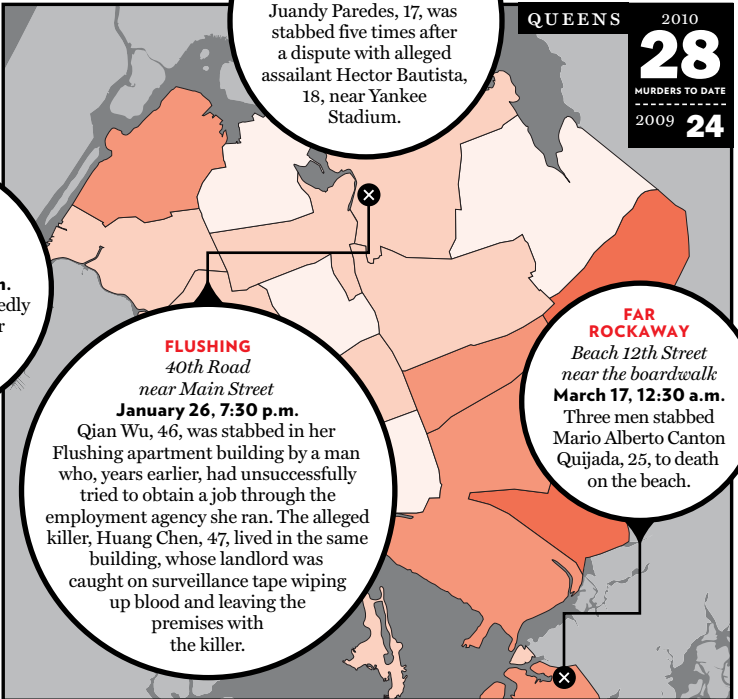
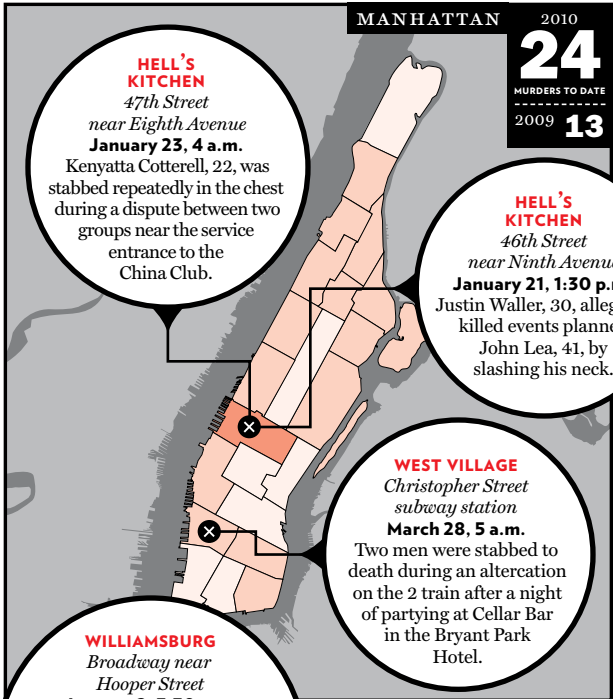
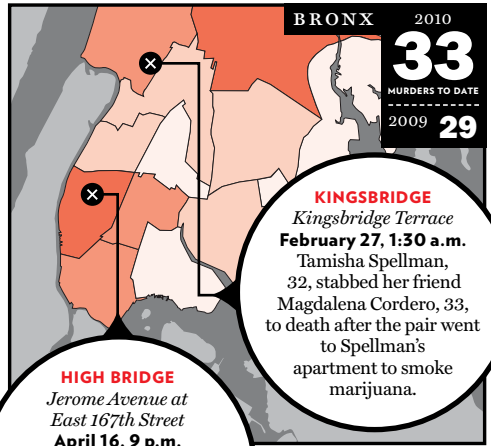
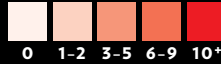
MURDER ON THE MAP
